Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

Under the direction of the Director, individual will implement the policies, programs and functions for all aspects of the cellular therapies department; maintain surveillance of regulatory documents and technical advances in the CT field with an eye towards informing members and developing position papers and impact analyses; assist in the development of educational and training materials for conferences; audio conferences, distance learning, publications and similar forums; review reimbursement related documents, assist in the development of tools for members regarding reimbursement of CT services and products; serve as key contact and/or staff liaison for CT related committees and subsections as requested; represent AABB at professional meetings.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- Individual must possess advance knowledge and understanding of regulations and regulatory considerations for CT products including practical implementation and a keen understanding of the needs of healthcare professionals.
- Advance knowledge and understanding of current best practices and quality system components for all aspects of cellular therapy and working knowledge of donor screening, testing, collection, processing, storage, and infusion methods.
- Must possess excellent organizational skills, with demonstrated ability to manage multiple projects and meet deadlines. Ability to contribute to and manage team or group projects. Ability to identify issues and prioritize workload.
- Strong analytical skills: Ability to prepare concise, well-written reports, letters and other written correspondence. Ability to analyze data such as surveys and to prepare for publication or electronic posting.
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills, including the ability to make oral educational presentations, as well as presentations to other professional organizations. Ability to work with a variety of groups, individuals and organizations including but not limited to HRSA, NMDP, FDA, ISCT, etc.

Education and Experience:

Bachelor's degree in a biological science or related discipline required; MT (ASCP) preferred. Minimum three to five years progressive working experience in technical, quality and compliance activities related to CT manufacturing. Experience with cord blood is preferred. Knowledge of AABB Standards and regulatory requirements (FDA, CMS), and quality systems is required.
